Treasurer: Nancy has been in contact with Chuck Gundersen, and he's on board with training in order for him to take over as treasurer in March.

Development: Tessa reported that donor money has been coming in. She will leave a list of donors and cards in the library so the trustees can write thank you notes as soon as possible. We will use the same check off system as last year.

Community Outreach: Tina, as well as Anne, has spoken with local author, Cameron Clifford, about his new book based on the founding fathers of area towns. Anne suggested an interview style presentation, which he agreed to. She will do the interview and send the questions to Cameron ahead of time. Tina will look into Sunday afternoons in February for a possible date. Anne also came up with another idea after talking to Kevin Geiger, whose specialty is emergency management. She thought maybe a panel discussion on climate change would be interesting and worthwhile. It will be explored further with the possibility of a late April/early May date. Betsy spoke with Mark Binder and set a tentative date of Friday, March 13, for the next "Moth".
