David explained the Pomfret Elementary School Budget Operating Results FY2012 - FY2014 with a Net Operating Surplus of \$33, 834 for FY 2014. FY 2012 had a surplus of \$86,416 and FY 2013 had a surplus of \$52, 975. We talked about the Pomfret Reserve Fund and discussed consolidating some of the accounts.

- *WCSU Principles will start budgets in October with Alice Worth, Superintendent.
