# Reports

## Library: Cory Smith and Sue Heston

- Cory will submit the library report to the state in late March.
- Excess books will be donated to the Five College Book Fair. Cory and Sue will request help with transportation from the trustees if needed.
- Storytime has not been well attended and Liz (volunteer) has been putting together additional craft bags which have been very popular.
- There has been more after-school traffic, partly driven by events at Artistree.

## Building and Grounds: Betsy Rhodes

- Samples of bat guano from the attic that Betsy sent to the VT Department of Fish and Wildlife have been analyzed and show that we have a healthy population of big brown bats.
- The Radon readings in the basement and the library still fluctuate. Betsy continues to explore causes and avenues of mitigation.
- The recommendations from the South Pomfret Scoping Study are due to be presented during the Pomfret Selectboard Meeting on March 1st.

#### Treasurer: Susan Burgess

- Susan distributed financial reports prior to the meeting.
- They were discussed and approved.

# Development: Mary Worrell

• Donations in response to the annual appeal are currently at about \$10.5K. This is in line with previous fundraising cycles, but a little less than last year.

# Outreach/Community Liaison: Jocelyn Randles, Cara DeFoor

- The green burial event is due to be held on March 12<sup>th</sup> at 2pm. Jocelyn will do promotion and Artistree paperwork, but will be out of town for the event and so Cara will lead set up, introductions etc.
- Betsy will explore whether a Moth event is possible for late March.
- Cara and Mary will coordinate on timing for poetry events (probably Jeff Bernstein et al in April and Laura Foley in May).
- Mary responded to a request from the librarians to have an event connected to the Vermont Reads selection (graphic/illustrated accounts of migrant workers in VT called *The Most Costly Journey*). She is going to explore online resources and possibly lead a discussion. This would need to take place before the end of May.

## Chair: Tina Clifford

• Trustee roles for next year were discussed but not determined. This issue will be revisited at the next meeting when the new trustee is in attendance.

## Old Business

• Sue H. has introduced Cara to the admin involved in organizing traffic control for the half marathon. Cara may assume responsibility next year.
