# Reports

Cory Smith (Librarian)

- The children's programming grant was awarded, and we will set a date for a Learning to Draw opportunity for elementary and middle school ages.
- June 30<sup>th</sup> marks the end of the fiscal year. The board reviewed the year-end budget and fiscal reporting will be submitted to the Town by June 21st.
- The board discussed its intention to use Ira Abbott fund interest to cover a portion of the building and grounds expenses.

The board discussed and agreed to the income and expense reporting format that Mary has developed.

Betsy Rhodes (Building and Grounds)

- Some slate tiles have been replaced on the roof which is otherwise in good shape.
