Reports			

Cory Smith (Librarian)

- 27 kids participated in the summer reading program. They read, kept logs and will receive
 \$10 gift certificates to Yankee Bookstore
- The Journal craft project was a success, and we are now offering a decorated vase project.
- July 12th cartooning workshop was a success with 20 sign-ups, 16 attendees. Additionally, six parents were present.
- Cory submitted the courier grant application which will pay half of the courier service for interlibrary loan.

Betsy Rhodes (Building and Grounds)

- Chimney repair update: We need to find a new mason to fix the chimney deterioration in the attic
- Continuation of discussion regarding plans to delineate parking spots, using bollards to pull traffic away from the guardrail, and plantings/vegetation along the stream bank.
- Betsy has pruned shrubs at The Teago Store and pulled poison parsnip.
- The library will participate as part of the town's oil pre-buy program.

Jocelyn Randles (Development)

- Jocelyn drafted and circulated a draft of the annual appeal letter.
- The board discussed the process for updating the donor address list.

Old Business:

- The contract with the Woodstock History Center has been renewed.
- The board is in consensus that the library will cover the costs of the childcare tax.
- The board would like to obtain estimates for architectural plans for the Abbott building addition as needed for future grant applications.

New Business:

- The Summer MOTH program will be held on Friday Aug 30th at 7pm, with the theme "Is Patience a Virtue?". The board will advertise with flyers and a poster, set up event, and provide snacks.
- The board discussed the possibility of starting a book club.
- Knit and Stitch group proposed to meet monthly.
- The board would like to plan a teen focused event in November or December.
- The board voted to use Ira Abbott funds to sponsor a second annual puppet show. Cory will research the possibility of the following dates: Sat. Oct 19, 26 or Nov 2nd.
