1. Circulation Statistics in January: 212 (last year: 152; in 2015: 212.).  
February: 133 (last year: 202; in 2015: 165).  
March: 227 (last year: 149; in 2015: 190).

2. Patron Tally in January: 181 (last year: 164; in 2015: 190).  
February: 175 (last year: 194; in 2015: 212).  
March: 178 (last year: 178; in 2015: 214).

# new patrons in January, February, March: 2 total.

Computer use in January: 7 users/ 2.25 hours (last year: 7 users/ 6.5 hours).  
February: 2 users/ 1.5 hours (last year: 4 users/ 3.75 hours).  
March: 5 users/ 1.25 hours (last year: 15 users/ 7.5 hours).

WiFi use recorded in January, February, March: 11 users/ 9.75 hours total.
